

## **SYNOPSIS**

Ayla, a young Turkish-German woman, is beautiful, self-confident and at odds with her conservative family, who disapprove of her "Western" lifestyle. She falls in love with Ayhan, but doesn't suspect his involvement in a murderous plan to restore his family's honor: his sister Hatice has left her unloved husband in Turkey and is raising her daughter alone in Germany. Pursued by thugs hired by her own family, Hatice finds refuge with Ayla, who once also fought for her freedom.

Pursued by her own family, Hatice finds refuge with Ayla, who is dismayed to learn that Hatice's brother is none other than Ayhan! Although he is against punishing his sister, he is the eldest son, and the task falls to him... Ayhan tries in vain to talk to her and convince her to return to her husband in Turkey. He also begs Ayla to believe him when he says he would never harm his sister, and tries to smooth his hot-headed younger brother Mehmet. But then Mehmet takes things into his own hands. And Ayla feels that this time she must put her life on the line for another woman's freedom.

## THE DIRECTOR

Self-taught filmmaker Turhan began his career in 1998 by writing, directing and producing his first short "Der Schlüssel". In 2001, on having worked in the film industry he shot (together with DoP Michael Ballhaus) "Gone Underground". Worldwide the first short feature fully shot and postproduced in HD. Besides numerous other festivals Turhan was also invited to the Sundance Film Festival. He continued writing for several production companies, and worked again with DoP Michael Ballhaus on his third short "Triell" in 2004. Turhan also directed commercials and documentaries for German and International TV, such as "Hightech for Champions" for Discovery Channel in 2005.
