

LOGLINE

A feverish thriller that unites two major German movie stars for the first time: Moritz Bleibtreu (RUN LOLA RUN, SOUL KITCHEN) and Jürgen Vogel (THE WAVE, THE FREE WILL).

SYNOPSIS

Eric (Jürgen Vogel) just wants to lead a mellow life and take care of his motorcycle workshop. He spends his free time with his new girlfriend Julia (Petra Schmidt-Schaller) and her small daughter. It could all be so perfect. But this seemingly happy world comes to an abrupt end when a weird stranger, Henry (Moritz Bleibtreu), forces his way into Eric's life. Like a parasite, there's no shaking him off. His annoying and cynical way of doing things provokes and pushes Eric to the edge of madness. But when more shady characters surface, claiming to know Eric, threatening to do him serious harm if he doesn't join in their dirty business, his life is destined to go right off the rails. Backed into a corner and with no way out, Eric has no choice but to rely on Henry. But can he be trusted?

PRESS NOTE

Scriptwriter and director **Maximilian Erlenwein** (GRAVITY), who has already been honored for his highly noted theatrical debut GRAVITY with the Max-Ophüls Award and the First Steps Award, among others, secured the participation of two of the most popular German actors of today for his film, **Jürgen Vogel** (MERCY, GRAVITY, THE WAVE) and **Moritz Bleibtreu** (SOUL KITCHEN, THE BAADER MEINHOF COMPLEX, THE ELEMENTARY PARTICLES), who are thus starring together in lead roles for the first time. Responsible for the visual design is **Ngo The Chau** (DAS LEBEN IST NICHTS FÜR FEIGLINGE, TOM SAWYER, GRAVITY), who garnered the German Camera Award. Editing was conducted by Sven Budelmann (THE PHYSICIAN, YOUNG GOETHE IN LOVE).

STEREO is a Frisbeefilms & Kaissar Film Produktion, in coproduction with ZDF - Das kleine Fernsehspiel and Wild Bunch Germany, in association with ARTE. Producers are Alexander Bickenbach, Manuel Bickenbach and Khaled Kaissar. Co-producers are Marc Gabizon and Amelie Kienlin of Wild Bunch Germany. Story editing is in the hands of Lucas Schmidt (ZDF), Olaf Grunert (ZDF/ARTE) and Andreas Schreitmüller (ARTE).

IN FRONT OF THE CAMERA

JÜRGEN VOGEL as Eric

Born in Hamburg in 1968, Jürgen Vogel numbers among the most renowned actors in Germany. His career in front of the camera began in his youth as a child model. The film world discovered him at the age of 15, but it was in Sönke Wortmann's feature LITTLE SHARKS in 1991 that he made his major breakthrough.

Although Jürgen Vogel left acting school after only one day, he has been fascinating audiences since then in many TV and cinema productions thanks to the extraordinary variety of his roles. Whether as criminal, a vengeful brother, a murderer, petty crook or loving husband – Jürgen Vogel consistently wins over TV and theatrical audiences through his nuanced acting.

He scored another big success alongside Christiane Paul as a slaughterhouse worker in Wolfgang Becker's LIFE IS ALL YOU GET (1997). He starred in Doris Dörrie's relationship drama NAKED in 2002 with Nina Hoss, Alexandra Maria Lara and Memet Kurtulus.

Through his courage to slip into uncomfortable roles, Jürgen Vogel became one of the most important actors in German auteur films. In no fewer than three films by Matthias Glasner – THE FREE WILL (2006), THIS IS LOVE (2009) and MERCY (2012) – he proved his ability to master thematically difficult subjects. In contrast, he also showed his versatility in hit comedy roles such as WHERE IS FRED? (2006) and RABBIT WITHOUT EARS (2007).

Vogel revealed a particularly experiment-loving side of himself in Lars Kraume's KEINE LIEDER ÜBER LIEBE (2005) next to Heike Makatsch and Florian Lukas. The script was based on only a few instructions. During the shooting a fake documentary was shot, in which Vogel toured Germany as lead singer of the band "Hansen", which was especially founded for the film, and sang live before a genuine public.

In 2013 he thrilled audiences in Oskar Roehler's epic SOURCES OF LIFE and played the strict father in the equine adventure WINDSTORM.

In the course of his career, Jürgen Vogel has won many awards: he obtained the Bavarian Film Award as "Best Young Actor" for ROSAMUNDE (1989). For LITTLE SHARKS (1991) he was given the "Actor's Award" of the Bavarian Film Award in 1992, the Bavarian Film Award as "Best Actor" for EMMAS' BLISS (2007), and the German Film Award as "Best Lead Actor" for LIFE IS ALL YOU GET (1997). For his outstanding artistic oeuvre as actor, co-author and coproducer of the film THE FREE WILL (2006), Vogel obtained a Silver Bear at the 2006 Berlin Film Festival and was honored that same year as "Best Actor" at the TriBeCa Film Festival as well as with the "Silver Hugo Award" at the Chicago Film Festival. His role in WHERE IS FRED? (2006) and in A FRIEND OF MINE (2006) brought him the Ernst Lubitsch Award. For the TV production THE PHANTOM (2000. director: Dennis Gansel), he also obtained an Adolf Grimme Award.

MORITZ BLEIBTREU as Henry

Born in Munich in 1971, Moritz Bleibtreu ranks among the most beloved and well-known actors in Germany. He found his way to acting via his mother, Monica Bleibtreu, whose work fascinated him already in his childhood. After various temporary jobs as au-pair, waiter and cook, he attended various acting courses in Paris, Rome and New York, and made his first appearance on screen as the Turk Yüksel in Peter Timm's SIMPLY LOVE in 1994. The following year, Bleibtreu, at the side of Katja Riemann, became known to a vast audience as a carpenter with a predilection for Spider Man comics in TALK OF THE TOWN (1995). He made his definitive breakthrough in 1997 as the petty criminal Abdul in KNOCKIN' ON HEAVEN'S DOOR. He was honored for both films with the Ernst Lubitsch Award. For KNOCKIN' ON HEAVEN'S DOOR he also won the German Film Award as "Best Supporting Actor."

From then on he starred in many feature films such as Detlev Buck's satire LOVE YOUR FEMALE NEIGHBOR (1998), RUN LOLA RUN (1999) next to Franka Potente and MOON FATHER (2000)



as the village idiot. In 2000 Moritz Bleibtreu appeared in Fatih Akin's IN JULY as a student teacher who, after an odyssey through Europe, realizes that he has already found the love of his life, for which he won the German Film Award as "Best Lead Actor." He received this award again the following year for his chilling role in THE EXPERIMENT (2001). Bleibtreu achieved cult status in his fan community in the role of the small-town stoner Kai in LAMMBOCK (2001), who runs not only a pizzeria with his best friend Stefan, but also a little marijuana plantation.

In the following years, Bleibtreu was repeatedly able to demonstrate his versatility as actor – as the drug-dealing son of an Italian migrant family in SOLINO (2002), again under director Fatih Akin; as sex-crazy loser Hans-Jörg in Oskar Roehler's AGNES AND HIS BROTHERS (2004); as right-hand man of Henry Hübchen in the gangster farce C(R)OOK (2005) and in Helmut Dietl's tragically beautiful romantic comedy ABOUT THE LOOKING FOR AND FINDING OF LOVE next to Alexandra Maria Lara.

In 2006 he worked again with Oskar Roehler in his grandiose Houellebecq adaptation ELEMENTARY PARTICLES (2006), starring in the role of Bruno, which won him a Silver Bear as "Best Actor" at the Berlinale. In 2008 Bleibtreu lent his talent to the portrayal of Andreas Baader in Uli Edel's THE BAADER MEINHOFF COMPLEX. In his third project with Fatih Akin, Bleibtreu played the slightly criminal but charming llios, who helps his brother save his restaurant in SOUL KITCHEN (2009).

In 2012 he starred in two feature films, Dennis Gansel's THE YEAR OF THE SNAKE and Til Schweiger's THE GUARDIANS. In Oskar Roehler's ensemble film SOURCES OF LIFE of 2013, he played the role of Klaus Freytag, and starred alongside of Brad Pitt that same year as a German doctor in Marc Forster's WORLD WAR Z. In Sam Gabarski's comedy of errors VIJAY AND I he portrayed an unsuccessful actor who, disguised as an Indian gentleman, falls in love again with his own wife. Most recently, he was seen at the side of Benedict Cumberbatch in THE FIFTH ESTATE, the timely political thriller about the Wikileaks founder Julian Assange.

PETRA SCHMIDT-SCHALLER as Julia

At the 2007 Bavarian Film Awards Petra Schmidt-Schaller was celebrated in the laudatory speech as "most surprising new discovery" for her role in RUNAWAY HORSE (2007). Daughter of a family of actors, she is one of the most talented of her trade, and, thanks to her unique radiance, endows each of her roles with its own magic.

She portrayed Ada in Ralf Huettner's REINE FORMSACHE (2006) and Rosa in Jo Baier's NOT ALL WERE MURDERERS (2006). She was compelling in the moving drama THE SHARED HAPPINESS (2011), for which she was awarded the German Actor's Award as "Best Lead Actress" in 2012. Schmidt-Schaller was also seen in the feature films ALMANYA (2011) by Yasemin Samdereli, and in LÖWENZAHN – DAS KINOABENTEUER (2011). That same year she thrilled audiences in Markus H. Rosenmüller's culture-clash comedy SUMMER IN ORANGE as Baghwan disciple Amrita. Since 2013 she can be seen next to Wotan Wilke Möhring as investigator in the new NDR TATORT.

GEORG FRIEDRICH as Keitel

Born in Vienna in 1966, Georg Friedrich stands at the top of the roster of best-known Austrian actors. He attended the Krauss acting school in Vienna before he began starring in many, mainly Austrian film and television productions in 1983. In 2004 he was awarded the "European Shooting Star" at the Berlin Film Festival.

Georg Friedrich depicts men at the borders of society in an authentic and multilayered way. He made a strong impact with his uncompromising performance in films such as Detlev Buck's TOUGH ENOUGH (2006), Ulrich Seidl's IMPORT/EXPORT (2007) and Philipp Stölzl's NORTH FACE (2008). In 2011he played the lead role in two films shown at the Berlinale: alongside Sandra Hüller in Jan Schomburg's debut feature ABOVE US ONLY SKY, and as the SS "Hauptsturmführer" Rudi Smekal with Moritz Bleibtreu in Wolfgang Murnberger's MY BEST ENEMY. That same year he starred alongside Petra Schmidt-Schaller in Markus H. Rosenmüller's culture-clash comedy SUMMER IN ORANGE. Most recently he could be seen in German cinemas in Detlev Buck's MEASURING THE WORLD (2012).

BEHIND THE CAMERA

MAXIMILIAN ERLENWEIN Director and Scriptwriter

After studying sociology and media sciences in Marburg, Maximilian Erlenwein moved to Berlin, where he worked as camera assistant and later as freelance cameraman. In 1999 he began studying directing technique at the Deutsche Film- und Fernsehakademie Berlin, during the course of which he directed many short films which won several awards and were screened at festivals around the world. He has already guested with his films at the Taipeh Film Festival, the Berlinale, the Karlovy Vary Festival in Prague and the Clermont Ferrand Short Film Festival. He also obtained the Helene Schwarz Award for "Best Director" for his short film BLACKOUT, the award of the German Film Critics as "Best German Short Film" as well as the award for "Best International Short Film" at the Monterrey International Film Festival in Mexico. Next to his studies in directing, he continued to work as a cameraman and traveled to countries such as Thailand, Poland, Romania, Sierra Leone and the U.S. (New York) for reports, documentaries and TV productions.

Together with Robin von Hardenberg, Erlenwein founded the Fat Lady Filmproduktion in 2005, with which he has since been producing music videos, documentary films, image films and commercials. He obtained the German Advertisement Film Award in the category "Best Viral" in 2011 for the commercial "Bewerbungsgespräch."

Maximilian Erlenwein achieved prominence through his DFFB graduation film GRAVITY (2010) with Jürgen Vogel, Fabian Hinrichs and Nora von Waldstätten, for which he also wrote the script. His feature film debut, produced by Frisbeefilms, was awarded the First Steps Award as "Best Full-length Feature Film," the Max Ophüls Award in the categories "Best Film," "Best Script," "Best Lead Actor" and "Best Young Actress," was nominated for the German Film Award in the "Best Lead Actor" category, and was greeted with "a word of praise" at the international festivals in Seattle and Zurich.

NGO THE CHAU DoP

Ngo The Chau was born in Hanoi, Vietnam, in 1977. From 1999 to 2004 he studied cinematography at the Deutsche Film- und Fernsehakademie Berlin (DFFB), where he was awarded the Michael Ballhaus Promotional Award in 2003 for his outstanding achievements. Already during his studies, Ngo The Chau began working as a cameraman for film, TV and advertising. The Berlin resident also did the camera work for music videos by reputable artists such as Herbert Grönemeyer, Seed and Patrice. For the visual design of the Bremen TATORT: SCHEHERAZADE he obtained the German TV Award and the German Camera Award in 2005; he had already been nominated for Ludwig & Glaser's DETROIT (2003) the year before.

After Franziska Meletzky's ACCORDING TO THE PLAN (2006) with Dagmar Manzel and Corinna Harfouch, came Matthias Emcke's PHANTOM PAIN with Til Schweiger and Jana Pallaske in the lead roles in 2007. Two years later Ngo The Chau operated the camera for the winner of the Zurich Film Festival 66/67– FAIRPLAY IS OVER One year later he worked with director Maximilian Erlenwein – his first, very successful collaboration with him – on the multiple award-winning riff-raff dramedy GRAVITY with Jürgen Vogel and Fabian Hinrichs.

After filming the amusing culture-clash comedy ALMANYA (2011), he was responsible for the photography of Hermine Huntgeburth's TOM SAWYER (2011). At the side of director Christian Alvart, he was in charge of the visual design in two TATORT episodes: BOROWSKI UND DER STILLE GAST (2012) with Axel Milberg and Sibel Kekilli, and, in 2013, WILLKOMMEN IN HAMBURG, in which Til Schweiger made his widely discussed debut as TATORT investigator. Most recently Ngo The Chau operated the camera for DAS LEBEN IST NICHTS FÜR FEIGLINGE (2013) with Wotan Wilke Möhring in the lead role, and HIN UND WEG with Florian David Fitz, which is coming to theaters in 2014.

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HEIKE LANGE Set Design

Heike Lange obtained a degree in interior decoration and has been successfully working as set designer for advertising, TV and theatrical film productions since 2003. She made her debut as set designer in Marco Kreuzpaintner's coming-of-age comedy SUMMER STORM (2004). This was followed by Florian Gaag's hip-hop drama WHOLETRAIN (2001), the sex comedy SPECIAL ESCORT (2007) and THE WILD SOCCER BUNCH 5 (2008) by Joachim Masannek, where the bleak yet tongue-in-cheek mood of the vampire topic called for an apocalyptic stage set.

Heike Lange continued in her apocalyptic vein in 2011, where she created the lavish sets to the endof-the-world thriller HELL, Tim Fehlbaum's feature film debut with Hannah Herzsprung and Lars Eidinger in the lead roles. After having been in charge of the sets for Hans Steinbichler's TV police thrillers POLIZEIRUF 110; DENN SIE WISSEN NICHT, WAS SIE TUN (2011) and HATTINGER UND DIE KALTE HAND. EIN CHIEMSEEKRIMI (2013), she will be presenting further proofs of her talent as set designer no fewer than three times in movie theaters in 2014: in HANNA'S JOURNEY by Julia von Heinz, SCHOSSGEBETE by Sönke Wortmann and STEREO by Maximilian Erlenwein.

The feature films they have already produced have been successfully shown in theaters and on TV, as well as screened at German and international festivals, and have won various honors and festival awards.

They obtained a major success with NEVERMORE, which was awarded the Student Oscar by the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts & Science in Los Angeles. 66/67 – FAIRPLAY IS OVER was honored with the "Golden Icon Award" at the international Zurich Film Festival, 1. MAI was shown as the opening film of the Berlinale section "Perspektive Deutsches Kino," GRAVITY and LET THE CAT OUT OF THE BAG won the "First Steps Award" and were the recipients of many awards at the renowned Max Ophüls Festival, whereby GRAVITY also won the competition at the film festival. SHORES OF HOPE was presented at the Toronto Film Festival.

In the past years, Frisbeefilms has succeeded in building up a tight network of highly talented filmmakers, always with the aim of developing a personal, original handwriting and a long-term collaboration. Among them are, for example, the filmmakers Maximilian Erlenwein, David Dietl, Toke Constantin Hebbeln and Sven Taddicken; and the cameramen and women Ngo The Chau, Felix Novo de Oliveira and Daniela Knapp.

The latest productions, David Dietl's KING OF GERMANY (2013) and Maximilian Erlenwein's STEREO, are strong references for visual and narrative courage and for the broad spectrum of the firm, the first an intelligent comedy with Olli Dittrich and the second a modern-day thriller with Jürgen Vogel and Moritz Bleibtreu in the lead roles.

With this young and ambitious enterprise, he has set himself the goal of producing films for a large audience. Khaled Kaissar has already realized many coproductions and original productions. Kaissar Film has at its disposal a network of exciting young filmmakers and creative artists with whom he know that he will bring truly exceptional stories to movie theaters. In 2011 Khaled Kaissar obtained the Promotional Award of the German Film for the drama TRANSIT, thanks to a "production activity which places itself convincingly in the service of the narration at every moment" (br-online.de).

MOUNTAIN BLOOD, a theatrical historical drama, won the audience award in 2010 at the Munich Film Festival and the award of the Province of Verona at the Film Fetival della Lessinia (Italy). The Shanghai International Film Festival screened MOUNTAIN BLOOD in the international series "Panorama" in 2010. The Frankfurter Allgemeine characterized it as: "The ideal of the glorification of love."

The documentary THE TURTLE'S RAGE premiered in cinemas in May 2012 and was given a "Best Film" award along with a "Producer Award" at the Dubai International Film Festival. THE TURTLE'S RAGE was also honored with the "Regard Neuf Award" at the Visions du Réel 2012 in Nyon. The jury judged it as "a very lucid film that arose from the urgent need to revisit the trauma of exile." WILD BUNCH GERMANY Co-production & Distribution

In April 2009, Wild Bunch Germany was established as a subsidiary of Wild Bunch S.A. Paris for allrights acquisition and distribution of feature films for German Speaking Europe. Wild Bunch SA has been an established distributor in the international independent sector for many years now. In addition to Germany (Wild Bunch Germany) and France (Wild Bunch Distribution, Wild Side), the company also has distributor branches in Italy (BIM) and Spain (VERTIGO).

Since April 2009, Wild Bunch Germany has been operating as an independent film distributor, having successfully released more than 45 feature films into German cinemas to date. These movies range from mainstream productions such as HOPE SPRINGS (2012) with Meryl Streep and Tommy Lee Jones or SCREAM 4 (2011) directed by Wes Craven, to art house productions including RUST AND BONE (2013) directed by Jaques Audiard, THE HUNT (2013) directed by Thomas Vinterberg, IN THE LAND OF BLOOD AND HONEY (2012) directed by Angelina Jolie or POLISSE (2011) directed by Maïwenn Le Besco, to genre titles like SPRING BREAKERS (2013) directed by Harmony Korine, KILLING THEM SOFTLY (2012) directed by Andrew Dominik, 22 BULLETS (2010) with Jean Reno, PARANORMAL ACTIVITY (2009) directed by Oren Peli or INSIDIOUS (2011) directed by James Wan—to name but a few.

HUT IN THE WOODS (2012) directed by Hans Weingartner and SHORES OF HOPE (2012) directed by Toke C. Hebbeln were the first German productions to be represented in Wild Bunch Germany's distribution program. Wild Bunch Germany is becoming an increasingly active coproduction partner at both the national and international level, involved in projects such as STEREO (2014) or the film adaption of bestseller novel HECTOR AND THE SEARCH FOR HAPPINESS (2014).

The booking and billing of Wild Bunch theatrical releases is handled by Central Film, a German joint venture company held by Wild Bunch and Senator Film.

Wild Bunch Germany currently owns the rights to an extensive library of cinema, video, video on demand and TV rights. Currently comprising approximately 250 titles, this collection continues to grow.

Wild Bunch Germany is represented by Managing Director Marc Gabizon and Head of Legal & Business Affairs Markus Aldenhoven. Amelie von Kienlin is in charge of co-productions. Director of Marketing is Götz Gerlach.

BETA CINEMA – WORLD SALES

Beta Cinema has established itself as a "boutique-operation" for independent feature films with strong theatrical potential. Beta Cinema's philosophy is to keep its selective acquisition policy of 10 to 12 titles per year in order to fully develop the theatrical potential of each title according to its individual character.

Beta Cinema's portfolio includes outstanding productions like Berlin 2013 Golden Bear-winning CHILD'S POSE, Academy Award 2011-nominated IN DARKNESS, Cannes 2008 Jury Prize-winning and Academy Award-nominated IL DIVO, Academy Award 2007-winning THE COUNTERFEITERS, Academy Award 2007 nominated MONGOL, Academy Award 2006-winning THE LIVES OF OTHERS and the Academy Award 2004-nominated DOWNFALL.
