THE DIRECTOR

David Wnendt was born in 1977 in Gelsenkirchen and grew up as the son of a diplomat in Islamabad, Miami, Brussels and Germany. After graduating in Business Administration and Journalism from Berlin Free University and completing a one-year film course at the Film and TV School of the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague, he was accepted at the renow-ned University of Film & Television "Konrad Wolf" in Potsdam-Babelsberg in 2004. Wnendt received the Bavarian Film Award for Best Young Director, the Young German Cinema Award, the Prix Genève-Europe for Best Screenplay and the First Steps Award for Best Full-Length Feature Film. His films include COMBAT GIRLS (2012) and WETLANDS (2013).
